Prof Robert McCorquodale "Human Rights: Law v Medicine"

Doctors and lawyers are often seen as opposing each other in relation to human rights. Can there really be a "right to health"? Prof. McCorquodale will consider some ways in which the legal system and medical practices can appear to be in conflict, and how both law and medicine can work together towards a protection of human dignity that underpins human rights.

Professor Robert McCorquodale is the Director of the British Institute of International and Comparative Law in London. He is also Professor of International Law and Human Rights, and former Head of the School of Law, at the University of Nottingham. Previously he was a Fellow and Lecturer in Law at St. John's College, University of Cambridge and at the Australian National University in Canberra.
